

GLOBAL LAUNCH FOR LATEST HILLSONG UNITED DOCUMENTARY

Hillsong United premieres part two of its *I Heart Revolution* documentary, *We're All In This Together* at more than 500 US and Canadian cinemas this week.

Made by the internationally respected Australian worship band, the on-the-road documentary captures the worship experiences, culture, and stories of young people they've met across six continents, 42 nations and 93 cities.

Hillsong United's Joel Houston says that the film wraps up three or four years of 'experience and revelation, and our passions in an hour and a half'.

"It touches on a lot of different things for individuals, and for the Church," he says.

"My prayer is that the documentary will speak to people where ever they're at, regardless of what their experience of God or church has been.

"For people who don't believe that Jesus is the Son of God, that's their eyes will be open to Him in a whole new light.

"For people who've been in church for a long time and are perhaps comfortable in that setting, that they will be challenged to see worship as an expression of their faith outworked more practically.

"And for people who have been burnt by the idea of the church and religion, that they will see God's plan in a whole new light," he explains.

"But above all, my prayer is - that after people see this - people will be inspired to work together as the Body of Christ, like never before.

"That's the great potential. To see a Church that is more and more unified, prepared to put its [own individual] agendas aside and work together for the common cause of Christ, which I believe is a message of love, compassion and hope for all people," Houston says.

The US and Canadian premiere takes place on November 4.

Before the documentary starts, cinemas will cross live to Sydney for a live concert featuring several new songs from Hillsong United.

The film will premiere in Australia, New Zealand and South Africa on November 18 at 6:45PM. A recording of the November 4 concert will introduce the night.

Nineteen (largely Hoyts) Australian cinemas will premiere the film.
